Dear Valued Customer,

Pacific Coast Fresh is actively monitoring the ongoing CDC and FDA investigation into a multistate outbreak of Cyclospora infections.

According to updates issued by the CDC and FDA on July 16, 2026, the outbreak has been linked to shredded iceberg lettuce served at certain restaurant locations in Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio, and West Virginia. FDA traceback activities identified a supplier of shredded iceberg lettuce from Mexico within the implicated supply chain, and the investigation remains ongoing.

What You Need Know

- **Implicated Source:** CDC and FDA have linked this outbreak to shredded iceberg lettuce associated with specific Taco Bell locations. FDA has identified a supplier of shredded iceberg lettuce from Mexico through traceback activities.
- **Our Supply:** While we do carry shredded lettuce, we do not source shredded lettuce from Mexico.
- **Current Status:** No nationwide recall of iceberg lettuce has been announced at this time. Taylor Farms de Mexico has issued a voluntarily withdrawal of iceberg lettuce sourced from central Mexico from the U.S. market.

- While no products supplied by Pacific Coast Fresh have been identified by FDA as part of this investigation, we will continue to monitor developments closely and will immediately communicate any information that may impact our customers.

Our Recommendation:

- While our US-sourced lettuce is not part of the FDA's current warning, we recommend that all customers continue to follow the guidance and recommendations published by the FDA and CDC.
