



Urgent: Food Recall Notification for California-Grown Conventional Yellow and White Peaches

Pacific Coast Fresh Company is participating in a voluntary recall initiated by Moonlight Companies on Californian Grown Conventional Yellow and White Peaches.

Moonlight Companies is voluntarily recalling California-grown conventional yellow and white peaches because they have the potential to be contaminated with *Listeria monocytogenes*, an organism that can cause serious and sometimes fatal infections in young children, frail or elderly people, and others with weakened immune systems. Healthy individuals may suffer only short-term symptoms such as high fever, severe headache, nausea, abdominal pain, and diarrhea. *Listeria* infection can cause miscarriages and stillbirths among pregnant women.

This recall is being conducted because *Listeria monocytogenes* was identified in the packing facility environment.

No illnesses have been reported to date.
