



Alert: Taylor Fresh Foods Recall of Products Containing Jalapeño Peppers

To Our Valued Customers and Partners, this is to advise you that **Pacific Coast Fresh Company is NOT involved** with the recent Taylor Fresh Foods recall of products containing jalapeño peppers.

Taylor Fresh Foods has announced a voluntary recall of certain finished products, including salsa, guacamole, dips, and prepared foods containing jalapeño peppers. The recall was initiated after notification that fresh jalapeños supplied through Coast Citrus Distributors may be associated with a multistate outbreak investigation involving Salmonella. Taylor Fresh Foods has discontinued sourcing from the implicated grower and is utilizing alternative suppliers. The recalled products were distributed to retail distribution centers in the following states: AL, AR, FL, GA, IL, IN, KS, KY, LA, MA, ME, MI, MN, MO, MS, NE, NH, NY, OH, OK, SC, TN, TX, VT, WI, and WV.

According to Taylor Fresh Foods, the recalled products were distributed primarily through retail channels under various brand names, including Freshness Guaranteed, Trader Joe's, Taylor Farms, and other private label brands. Taylor Fresh Foods reported that, as of the recall announcement, it was not aware of any illnesses linked specifically to the recalled finished products.

Pacific Coast Fresh Company has reviewed the information currently available and is not associated with the recalled products identified in this notification.
